- Maximum of **3 entries per class** for classes 1-14, and **10 entries in total** across all classes, per person.
- All prints must be mounted on mat board, thick card or foam core to facilitate display. No block mounts or framed prints.
- Name of exhibitor, class entered and title to be displayed clearly on the back of each print
- All classes other than small prints (class 12) have a minimum size (excluding mount) of 25x20cm and maximum size (including mount) of 50x40cm
- Entries may be reclassified at the discretion of the convenor

Monochrome Prints (Black and White, or shades of a single colour eg sepia)

1. People (mono)
2. Open (mono)

Colour Prints

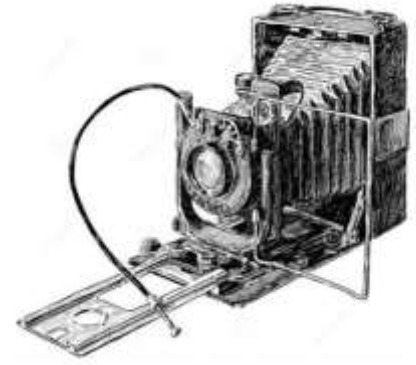
3. Fleurieu Landmarks (local landmark, either man-made or a geographical feature)
4. Flora/Flowers
5. Child Study (children up to 10 years old)
6. Rural Life (people and/or animals in a rural environment)
7. Nature (can include photos taken at a zoo or wildlife park)
8. People
9. Landscape
10. Seascape
11. Open (large prints)
12. Open (small prints) (minimum size 15x10 cm, maximum size 20x15 cm, excluding mount)
13. Photojournalism/Social Documentary
14. Digital Creative Art (original artwork created digitally)

Monochrome or Colour Prints

30. Historical Society Competition (photo of a building or place which is part of our district's heritage. The winning print will be retained by the Yankalilla and District Historical Society until a digital copy received)
31. Second Valley Challenge (photo taken within the environs of Second Valley. The winning print will be retained by the Second Valley Progress Association until a digital copy received)
