Please read schedule below carefully, as non-complying entries will not be accepted.

- Maximum of **3 entries per class** for classes 1-14, and **12 entries in total** across all classes, per person.
 - Print sizes (excluding mount. Long side may be horizontal or vertical).
Small prints (class 5) long side 15 - 20 cm, short side 10 - 15 cm
 - ALL OTHER classes** long side 20 - 42 cm, short side 20 - 29.7 cm. (ie maximum print size is A3)
 - All prints must be **mounted** on matboard or stiff card, 1 mm - 3 mm thick, and must provide a border of at least 40 mm on each side of the print. **NO** foam core, block mounts or framed prints. View hints for mounting prints at www.southcoastcameraclub.com/peshow.
 - Name of exhibitor, class entered and title to be displayed clearly on the back of each print
 - Entries may be reclassified at the discretion of the convenor
 - Prints & Digital Images are judged on photographic merit.

Entering your photos in both the Yankalilla and Port Elliot Shows.

To facilitate entering images in both the Yankalilla and Port Elliot Shows, Classes 1-14 at Yankalilla are the same as those in the Port Elliot Show, In addition, any prints entered in the Yankalilla Show which you also wish to enter in the Port Elliot Show, will be transferred to Port Elliot for you.

To indicate entries to be transferred, put "(PE)" at the end of their titles on the Yankalilla entry form. You will need to submit a separate entry form to the Port Elliot Show, and collect your prints from

the Port Elliot Showgrounds at the end of that Show. Go to portelliotshow.com.au for dates and rules for the Port Elliot Show photography section.

Please note in particular that the mounting requirements for Port Elliot are more prescriptive than those for Yankalilla.
