Definitions:

Cut flower: Two or more flowers or florets displayed on a single stem with secondary branches

Bloom: One flower displayed on a single stem

Distinct: Different colours

Floribunda: Cluster of flowers

Not Necessarily Distinct (NND): Can be the same colour

Novice exhibitor: one who has not won a first prize in the section that exhibitor is competing

Potted plants :

- a winning exhibitor may not exhibit the same article 2 years running
- every plant must be established in the container in which it is shown and be free from pests and diseases at the time of judging
- plants must be the property of the exhibitor for a minimum of 40 days prior to close of entries

All cuts to be staged by the exhibitor in bottle provided

Judges are empowered to give 2nd prize in lieu of 1st prize

2nd prize will only be awarded if more than 3 entries in that class.
