Definitions:

Cut flower: Two or more flowers or florets displayed on a single stem with secondary branches

Bloom: One flower displayed on a single stem, with a little foliage

Distinct: Different colours

Floribunda: Cluster of flowers

NND: Can be the same or different (Not Necessarily Distinct)

Novice exhibitor: One who has not won a first prize in the section that exhibitor is competing

Potted plants:

- a winning exhibitor must not exhibit the same article 2 years running
- every plant must be established in the container in which it is shown and be free from pests and diseases at the time of judging
- plants must be the property of the exhibitor for a minimum of 40 days prior to close of entries
- Potted plants not to **exceed 30cm**

All cuts to be staged by the exhibitor in bottle provided.

Judges are empowered to give 2nd prize in lieu of 1st prize.
